The East Cobb County Council (ECCC) PTA created the Margie Hatfield Scholarship Fund in order to honor the dedication and years of service given by Mrs. Hatfield to the youth of our Council PTA. It is with this service in mind that the ECCCC PTA sponsors the scholarship program to help deserving youth in their educational journey.

The Margie Hatfield Scholarship Fund awards six (6) separate \$1,000 scholarships; one student from each of the ECCCC PTA high schools will be chosen.

The following is a list of criteria used in screening applicants:

- Service-oriented projects, community involvement, and extra-curricular activities (40 points)
- Leadership, honors, and awards (20 points)
- Essay (15 points)
- References (10 points)
- Grade point average (10 points)
- Following instructions (5 points)

Important facts to know:

- Any graduating high school senior from the six ECCCC PTA schools enrolling in a full-time course of study at any institute of higher learning may apply.
- The funds must be used for continuing education.
- The applicant must be a member of their school's PTSA.
- Applications must be typewritten or printed legibly using blue or black ink and the guidelines followed exactly. Resumes should not be attached. Choose standard fonts. Do not write/type on the back of the application. **Applicants who do not adhere to the outlined specifications will be disqualified.**
- Include one personal reference (not related to you), one reference from your school and a sealed transcript.
- Completed applications should must be postmarked no later than **February 28, 2017 and mailed to:**
